How much space do you need between a galley & a U shaped island?

You will need at least 3 feet of space between your galley or U-shaped islands. Since the outdoor kitchen depth is at least 2 feet...Your galley or U-shaped outdoor kitchen dimensions will always be a minimum of 7 feet wide. The length is up to you. You want a minimum of 5 feet behind your grill islands for any bar stools to comfortably back out.
