

How do you stain metal?

Wipe the metal with a clean rag dampened with mineral spirits. If the metal was previously painted with dark paint, apply a base coat before staining. In the staining process, use a wood graining tool to apply a thin, uniform layer of Interior Oil Stain. Move the graining tool at a constant speed and use a rocking motion for a natural look.

How do you clean SSPC 10 metal?

Cleaning up to near-white metal (SSPC 10) can be achieved through power tool cleaning. These use an internal piston to drive a hardened edge against surfaces.
