How deep should a propane tank be buried?

However, they still have strict installation guidelines. Underground tanks retain the same level of clearance as above ground and must be placed at depth for safety. 100-gallon tanks: 44 inches buried. 500-gallon tanks: 4 feet, 6 inches. The distance requirements of underground and above-ground propane tanks are the same.

How far is a 120 gallon propane tank from a building?

Distance from building openings: 5 feet. Distance from ignition sources: 10 feet. While not as large as home-heating tanks, a 120-gallon tank will still store a rather large volume of propane. So make sure to keep it away by a good distance.

Why are LP gas tanks buried underground?

Since they are buried below the Earth's surface, they are naturally protected from extreme weather that can cause rust, peeling and corrosion (Understanding underground tank installation techniques - LP Gas (lpgasmagazine.com)). Also, underground tanks are buried, therefore, they are out of sight.

How deep should an underground tank be buried?

Larger underground tanks can be placed closer to the property lines and house, which makes them a good option if you expect high usage and don't have a lot of yard space. The depth an underground tank should be buried depends on the tank size.
